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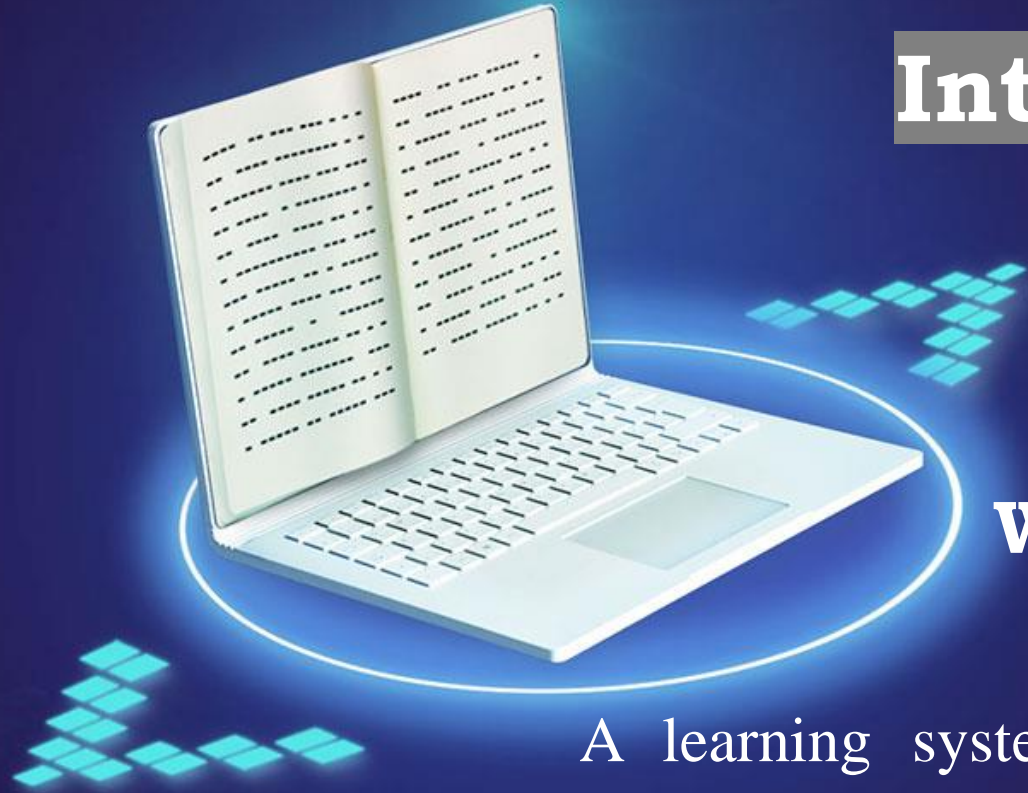
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Introduction

- To enable student to enroll the desired subjects, course materials and interact with them.

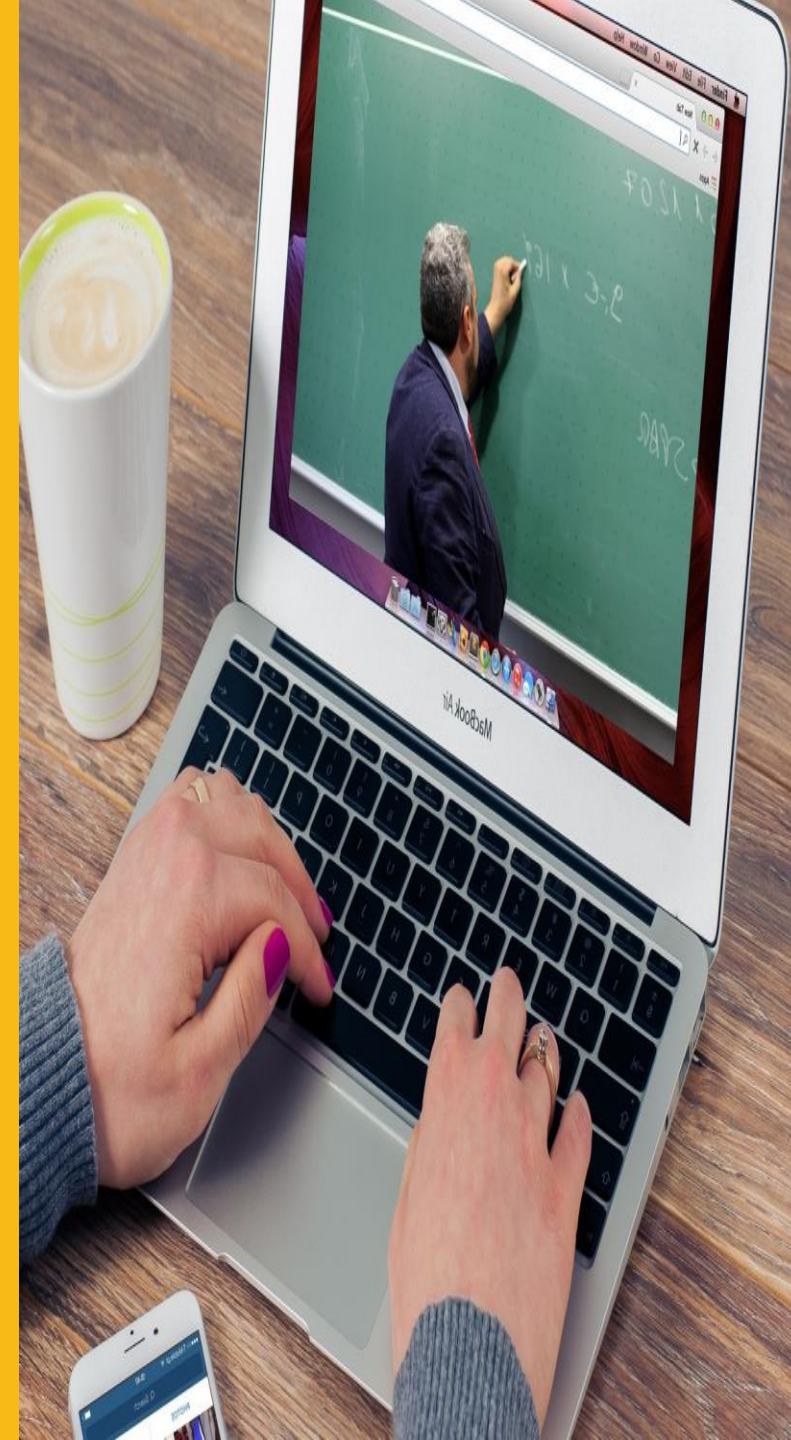
PROBLEM STATEMENT

- ❑ The conceptual model that defines structure, behavior and more views of a system.

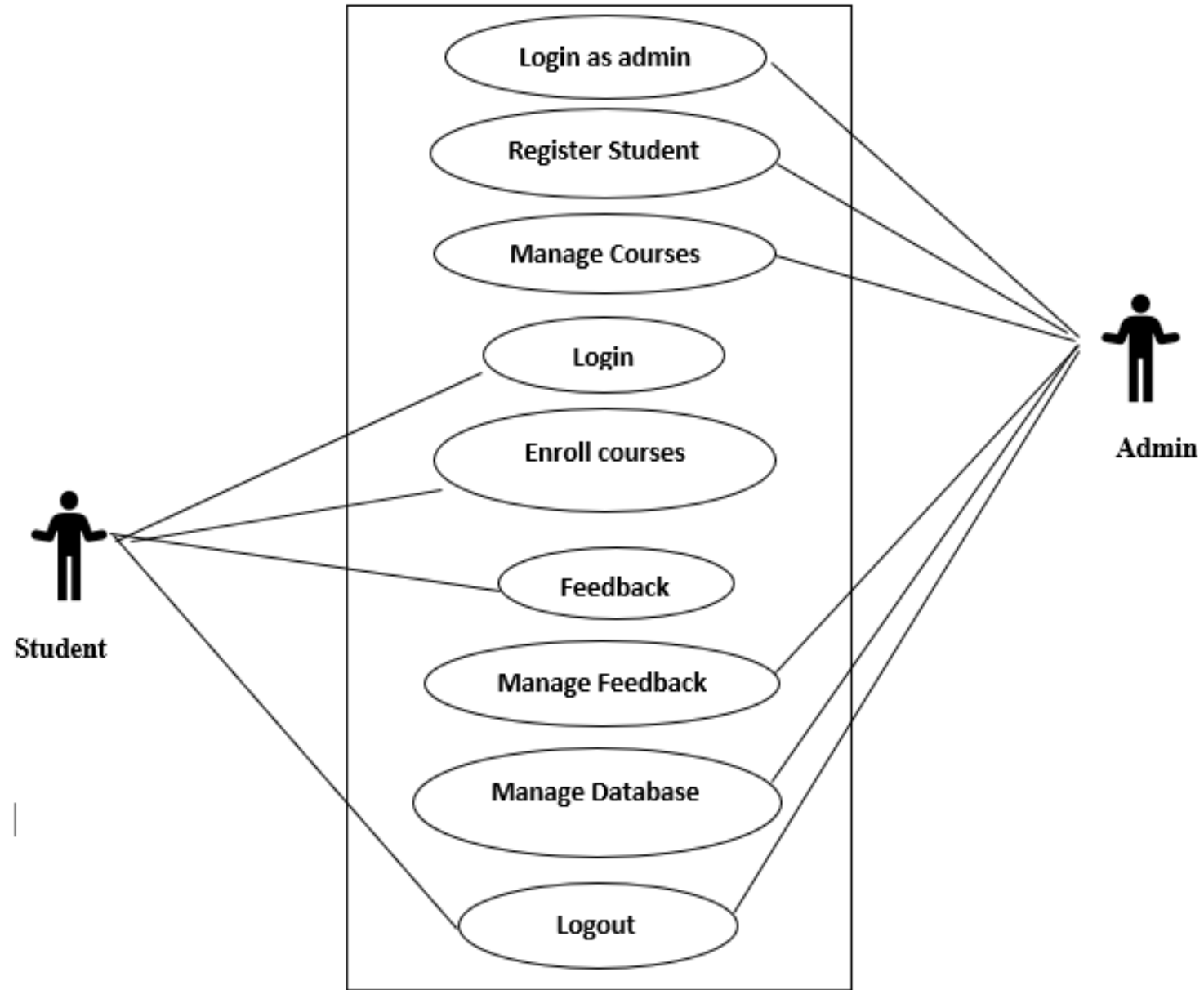


Figure: Use Case Diagram for E-Learning Management System

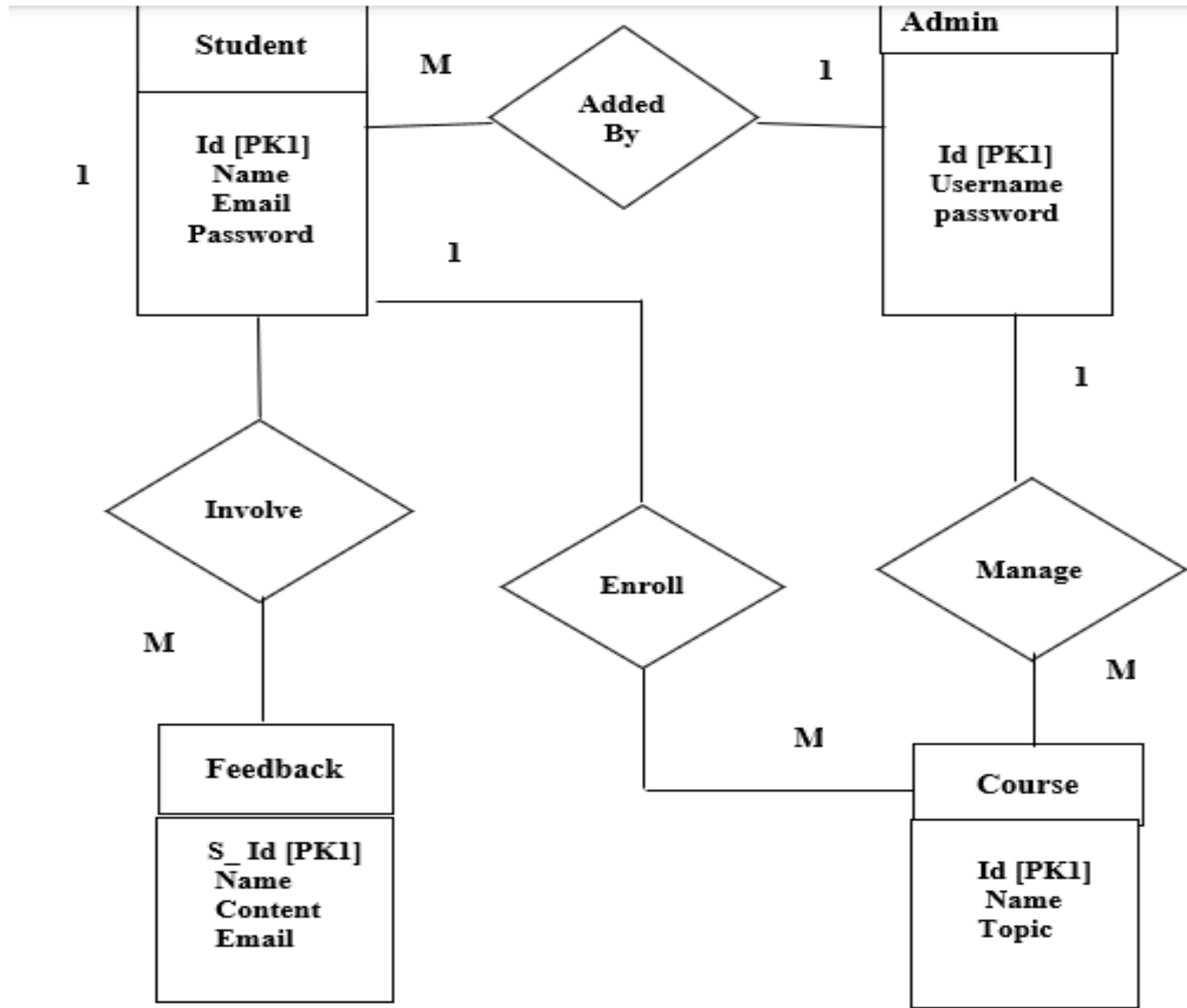


Figure: ER- Diagram for E-Learning Management System
